Agenda: Crisis

*\*This committee serves Double Points and is a Dual Delegate committee. Kennedy's Cabinet at JTMUN presents a unique and dynamic crisis cabinet experience, with dual points of view within a dual committee structure. This will feature all major crises part of one of the most hectic Presidential tenures in the history of the United States.*

### 3. Joint Anti-Terrorism Commission (JATC)

Agenda: Mitigating Terrorism and Preventing Escalation in the Aftermath of the 2025 India Pakistan Conflict.

*The Committee will be discussing the closest we have come to full scale war between Pakistan and India in recent times and how we can prevent future terror attacks and escalation of said situations. This will be a bilingual committee.*

### **3. THE DISARMAMENT & INTERNATIONAL SECURITY COMMITTEE**

Agenda: Evaluating the Proliferation of Anti Satellite Weaponry in light of the Outer Space Treaty (1967)

*\*This committee would be discussing the increase in supposed weapons capable of working or being launched from outer space and their existence considering the already vastly ratified Outer Space Treaty.*



## ECOSOC and Regional Bodies

### 1. BRICS

Agenda: Currency Cold War: The quest to de-dollarize

*This committee's main point of discussion would be about discussing the practicality and pursuit of de-dollarisation, i.e reducing the US dollar as a means of standard currency used within international trade and reserve, and strengthening either local currencies of member states or the entire creation of a new standardised one or even adopting an already existing one.*

### 2. UNCA-Press Corps

Agenda: Watchdog Journalism: The press as a monitor of government actions.

*Watchdog journalism refers to a type of investigative journalism where its entire purpose is to watch over government officials and their actions, exposing and critiquing corruption, misconduct and abuse of power.*

# The Gentlemen's Code

The JTMUN Society prides itself upon upholding the timeless values of respect, honour, and courtesy. In the spirit of true diplomacy, every delegate is expected to embody the dignity of an ambassador, ensuring that all interactions are conducted in an atmosphere of cordiality, civility, and mutual regard.

Though clothed in simplicity, the Gentleman's Code carries the weight of generations of diplomatic tradition. It is both a safeguard and a standard, ensuring that delegates feel not only welcomed, but honoured in their participation. Built upon the pillars of fairness, equality, and mutual understanding, the JTMUN Society is resolute in fostering a safe and refined environment where every delegate may flourish.

To preserve this tradition of excellence, the following Code shall be observed with the utmost seriousness, as it reflects the very character of those who aspire to statesmanship.

## The Code:

1. Dignity of Office
  - a. Delegates shall carry themselves with the measured dignity expected of ambassadors.
  - b. Attire must reflect professionalism and respect for the institution they represent. Both Western formal dress (such as a suit and tie) and traditional Eastern attire are equally welcome, provided they are worn neatly and respectfully
  - c. Conduct, posture, and bearing should inspire confidence and respect.
  - d. Delegates must remain mindful that they embody the voice and presence of their nation or institution.
2. Respect and Cultural Sensitivity
  - a. Delegates shall demonstrate tolerance and respect towards persons of all backgrounds, cultures, and opinions.
  - b. Privacy and personal space must be respected at all times.
  - c. Derogatory remarks, cultural insensitivity, or personal attacks are strictly prohibited.
3. Prohibition of Intimidation and Impropriety
  - a. Any form of harassment, coercion, or intimidation contradicts the principles of diplomacy and will result in immediate removal from proceedings.
  - b. Delegates shall resolve disagreements through dialogue and persuasion, not hostility.



4. Speech and Diplomacy
  - a. Delegates must speak in a respectful, courteous, and measured tone at all times.
  - b. Shouting, interrupting, or attempts to dominate through volume rather than reason are deemed unacceptable.
5. Professional Conduct
  - a. Delegates must be punctual for all committee sessions.
  - b. The Dais is to be addressed with formality and courtesy, as the custodian of debate.
  - c. Behaviour both inside and outside committee sessions must reflect professionalism, for it represents the delegate's institution.
6. Confidentiality and Discretion
  - a. Discussions within committees are to be treated with seriousness and discretion.
  - b. Misuse of information, whether spoken or written, for personal advantage or to undermine another delegate, is strictly forbidden.
7. Use of Devices and Materials
  - a. The use of mobile phones, cameras, or laptops during formal committee proceedings is prohibited.
  - b. Speeches must be delivered without reliance on electronic devices.
  - c. Delegates must not engage in photography or videography inside committee rooms.
  - d. Delegates must inform the secretariat or any member of the management if they do not wish to be included in the photography or videography of the conference.
8. Lobbying Etiquette
  - a. Lobbying shall only occur at designated times and in designated spaces.
  - b. Any attempt to lobby in a manner that circumvents fairness will be considered a breach of the Code and may affect awards.
  - c. Delegates must maintain a respectful distance and composure during unmoderated caucuses to ensure orderly and safe interaction.
9. Prohibition of Substances
  - a. The possession or use of electronic smoking devices, tobacco, or any nicotine-related substance is strictly prohibited on the premises.
10. Financial Integrity
  - a. Delegation fees must be paid in full before the commencement of the conference. Failure to comply may result in restriction from participation.
11. Authenticity of Work
  - a. Pre-drafted resolutions and directives are strictly forbidden. All documents must originate from a genuine debate within the committee. Any violation will result in severe sanctions.

## Registration Guidelines

1. All the teams will be required to register via the online registration form and fill out the Waiver of Liability available on our website. Hence, a valid registration.
2. The payment of the delegate fee, delegation fees and the observer fee (where applicable) must be made within a week of receiving the registration form submission confirmation email from our email address. Details and the method of payment can be found within the registration form.
3. Participants must complete all registration requirements on time and double-check before final submission to avoid the risk of being excluded. Observers are required to register with their respective teams.
4. The registration team reserves the right to reject or disqualify any team/individual. Failure to adhere to the rules of the conference can lead to disqualification. JTMUN reserves the right to reject individual candidates if they fail to comply with our conference policies.
5. Each delegation may be composed of a maximum of 10 delegates. The minimum number of delegates allowed to register in a delegation is 6. These numbers include the Head Delegate.
6. A total of 9 Committees will be simulated.
7. Allotments will be finalised by the host team and emailed to the registered delegations within a week. Hence, committee preferences on the registration form are subject to change as per the will of the host team.
8. 3 committees (Kennedy's Cabinet, JATC and Press Corps) will feature unique allotments, which would be separate from the overall allotments for the rest of the committees for a delegation.
9. The allotments for UNSC will be limited to 15 Delegations.
10. Kennedy's Cabinet and the UNSC are double-point and dual delegate committees.
11. The Best Delegation will be based on individual team points. In case of a tie, the best delegation will be decided as per HMUN guidelines, which will be communicated to delegates.
12. For outstation delegations, accommodation details and information will be conveyed once the team gets in touch with our management.
